4 Year Old Classes



It's hard to believe, but February is already here. This month will be jammed packed with activities to keep our four year olds engaged in learning and developing their emerging skills. Please keep in mind our inclement weather policy – if Fort Mill Public Schools are delayed, preschool will close for the day. Please send your child in with a warm coat as we will bundle up and go outdoors most days.

February is Heart Health and Dental Health Month. We will spend time learning about healthy habits that promote overall wellness. We will also discuss community helpers and the important roles they play in keeping us healthy and safe.

During Community Helper Week, we will welcome special visitors, including a dentist, the Fort Mill Fire Department, a local farmer, a pilot, and a nurse, who will help us learn more about their jobs and how they serve our community.

We will continue to work on our alphabet letters listed on the calendar. We would like to encourage you to work with your child on the letter and letter sounds and number of the week. Be sure that your activities include both upper and lower case letters. If possible, allow your child to use a pair of children's scissors at home to cut old magazines, playdough, newspaper, etc. to help build the small motor muscles in their hands. This will strengthen writing skills. Also, any reading at home you do will greatly increase your child's vocabulary. Letting your child see you read will model the importance of reading.

Kindergarten registration will start at the end of March. During kindergarten registration your child will go through an academic screening. All children will be asked about letters, numbers, name writing, cutting, etc.


Friday, February 13th– Dentist–Rene Pitts from Pleasant Mill Pediatric will be joining us to discuss dental health.
