Friday, January 23rd– Registration for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year will begin for current students and siblings. (Conference Room of the YMCA at the Complex)


Wednesday, January 28th – Registration for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year will open to the public. (Community Room of the YMCA at the Complex)
