Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> -Muffins for Mom (or other significant person)

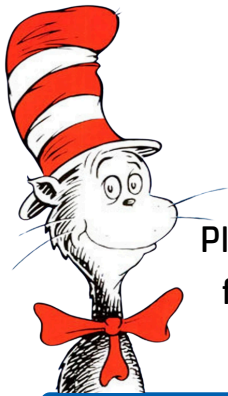

# It's Read Across America Week!

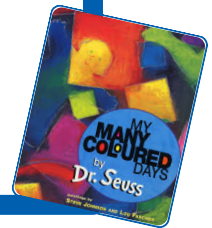
March 2–6, 2026

Please do not spend money purchasing costumes, as this is just for fun — feel free to use what you already have at home!

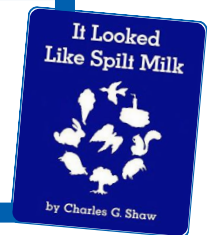
**MONDAY**
